BUSINESS MEETING IN SPRING ONLY

In the 2010-11 school year, we will only be holding a CPABC business meeting at our spring leadership conference. This is due to our involvement with the CSC conference in Edmonton. We will keep you posted on other developments as the year progresses.

NEW STRUCTURE FOR THE CPABC

The CPABC executive has been restructured to meet the needs of our mission and vision more effectively. The portfolios include Professional Development/Certificates, Conferences, SCSBC and Leadership/Policy/Government Relations, Chairperson, New Principals, CSC Rep, Promotions, Treasurer and Secretary. The summary of the new structure is as follows:

1. Give each CPABC Board member a focused portfolio of responsibility and the necessary time and/or money to do their task.
2. Take the time needed for Board tasks from a portion of the present 5 full-day board meetings of the CPABC, thereby reducing the number of meetings the committee will need to conduct business.
3. Pairs of CPABC Board members will work on their individual responsibilities during a morning and hold their "full" board meeting in the afternoon of the 5 or less designated meeting days.
4. CPABC Board agendas would largely consist of hearing and responding to the reports of the individual members.
5. All CPABC committee rep positions would be filled by CPABC Board members to enhance communication.
